Get to know Dominique Askew Shamburger of Montgomery

Dr. Dominique Askew Shamburger is a native of Birmingham. She obtained her Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from Howard University in Washington, DC, where she graduated with honors. She later went on to obtain her Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from The University of Tennessee Health Science Center in Memphis, TN. While in dental school, Dr.

Shamburger received various awards and recognitions including being awarded the senior award for Public Health Dentistry and Pediatric Dentistry. She was involved in research at the University of Tennessee Health Science Center and was selected to participate in the senior honors program. Her experience was further developed while in school by providing services through the Indian Health Service in Cherokee, NC.

Dominique continued her endeavors after dental school by successfully working to establish two dental offices in underserved areas with a non-profit organization. She later joined Health Services, Inc., where she currently serves as Dental Coordinator for the Montgomery Primary Health Center Dental Clinic. Her commitment to helping the underserved and to help decrease healthcare disparities prompted her to become a member of the National Health Service Corp.

Dominique also has a focus on organized dentistry and the community by holding professional memberships with the National Dental Association, American Dental Association, Alabama Dental Society and Alabama Dental Association where she currently serves on the Board of Trustees representing the Second District Dental Society.
